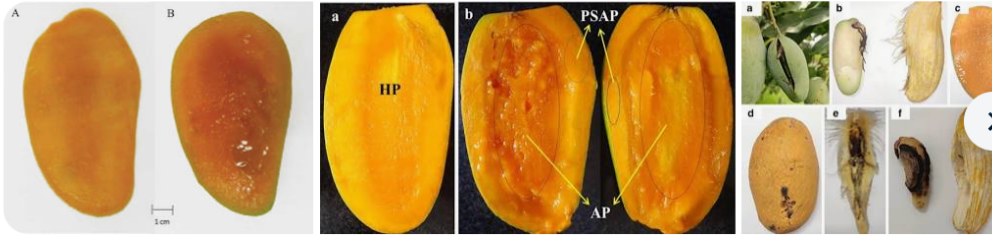


Jelly Seed Disclaimer & Refund Policy



Jelly seed is a physiological disorder in mangoes characterized by excessive softening, discoloration, and a jelly-like texture of the pulp around the seed, often making the fruit unmarketable. It is commonly caused by premature germination-related enzyme activity, calcium deficiency, or over-ripening, particularly in late-harvested fruits. [E ScienceDirect.com +2](#)

Indian mangoes are natural agricultural products, and certain varieties may occasionally develop naturally occurring internal physiological conditions such as “Jelly Seed Disorder.” This condition involves softening or jelly-like breakdown of pulp near the seed area and may not be externally visible at the time of shipment.

Jelly seed is generally associated with natural growing conditions, varietal susceptibility, environmental stress, ripening variability, and orchard nutrient balance. Since this is a naturally occurring internal condition, limited occurrence in some fruits does not necessarily indicate spoilage, mishandling, or shipping damage.

Customers are encouraged to inspect mangoes upon arrival and report concerns within 24 hours of delivery with clear photos of the cut fruit showing the edible portion affected.

Savani Farms continuously works with growers and orchard partners to minimize such occurrences and improve overall fruit quality through proactive agricultural practices and quality monitoring.

While Jelly Seed is a naturally occurring physiological condition that may occasionally affect certain mangoes, customer satisfaction remains very important to us.

If more than one-third (1/3) of the mangoes in a shipment are affected by Jelly Seed Disorder, Savani Farms may offer a replacement shipment or appropriate accommodation, provided that:

- The issue is reported within 24 hours of delivery
- Clear photos of the affected cut mangoes are submitted
- Complete feedback regarding the condition of the shipment is provided
